The AAPI-2 has proven invaluable in assessing the parenting attitudes and child-rearing beliefs of parents and adolescents. Founded on five parenting constructs known to lead to abusive parenting the AAPI provides scores that profile parents at risk for abusing and neglecting children. The philosophy of Nurturing Parenting emphasizes the importance of raising children in a warm, trusting and caring household. It is founded on the belief that children who are cared for develop the capacity to trust, care and respect themselves, other people and living creatures and the environment.

The Nurturing Parenting Programs®

The Nurturing Parenting Programs are family-based programs with a proven track record of preventing the recurrence of child abuse and neglect that address the specific needs of different populations

The Five Constructs/High Risk Belief Systems

- A. Inappropriate/Appropriate Expectations
- B. Low Level/High Level Empathy
- C. Strong Belief/Alternatives to Corporal Punishment
- D. Reverses/Appropriate Family Roles
- E. Restricts/Values Freedom/Independence

National Trainers Bettie Murchison and Jennifer Moss, MA will host *this 2-day training with a focus on understanding the parenting assessments: Adult-Adolescent Parenting Inventory (AAPI) and the Nurturing Skill Competency Scale (NSCS) and administering them successfully. Participants will learn how to use the online versions of these two assessments to gather pre and post program outcome data. In addition, we will do treatment planning and hypothesis through a multi-cultural exploration. Several parts of the day will be taught experientially and hands on, including the popular Nurturing Boot camp!*

This much anticipated training will close out the second day with an expert panel of NPP Trainers from various parts of the country to respond to Q & A about assessments and multi-cultural inclusion.
