The Nurturing Parenting® Programs
The Nurturing Parenting Programs are family-based programs with a proven track record of preventing the recurrence of child abuse and neglect that address the specific needs of different populations. Trauma-informed care defines "empathy," which is the cornerstone of the Nurturing Parenting Program. Initial research and development for the Nurturing Parenting Programs occurred in the early 1980s. National implementation began in 1985. Over the past 30 years, about 14,000 agencies have implemented NPP worldwide, reaching an estimated 2 million families. Approximately 30 studies have been published or described in evaluation reports. Nurturing Parenting Program is currently being implemented worldwide.

Philosophy of Nurturing Parenting®

The philosophy of Nurturing Parenting emphasizes the importance of raising children in a warm, trusting, and caring household. It is founded on the belief that children who are cared for grow to develop the capacity to trust, care for and respect themselves, other people, living creatures, and the environment.
