EVIDENCE BASED MEASUREMENT TOOLS:

Learn how to use the online **Adult-Adolescent Parenting Inventory** (AAPI) and the **Nurturing Skills Competency Scale** (NSCS) to gather pre and post program outcome data.

The AAPI assesses parenting attitudes and risk for abuse and neglect, while the NSCS gathers demographics and measures nurturing skills.

Feelings of Attachment – A strong, unconditional bond builds trust, communication, and respect.

Empathy – Understanding a child's feelings and responding with care and respect.

Nurturing Oneself – Meeting your own needs supports your ability to care for your child.

Gentle Touch – Warm, positive touch supports healthy relationships and self-worth.

Discipline – Teaching limits, values, and respect through positive role modeling.

Expressing Feelings – Learning healthy ways to understand and express emotions.

Expectations & Self-Worth – Realistic expectations help children build confidence and competence.
