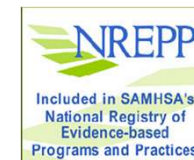

Participants will learn to:

- Design and implement parenting programs based on their families, community and cultural needs
- Learn to address the racism that complicates black parenting
- Incorporate experiential learning activities, personal and group reflection, home practice, and supportive group discussions to meet and address disparities to advocate for their children
- Increase parental and child knowledge so they are better equipped to manage stress, regulate emotions, implement positive discipline techniques, understand cultural differences, and advance social-emotional learning concepts

Participants will learn how to use these assessment tools:

Adult-Adolescent Parenting Inventory (AAPI-2)

The AAPI-2 has proven invaluable in assessing parenting attitudes and child-rearing beliefs of parents and adolescents. Founded on five parenting constructs known to lead to abusive parenting.

Nurturing Skills Competency Scale (NSCS)

The NSCS is an inventory designed to gather information, both past and current, about individuals and their families that could lead to the initial occurrence of child maltreatment or the recurrence of child maltreatment.

Nurturing Parenting Programs meet and exceed the 6 Protective Factors identified by the U.S. Government for the prevention and treatment of Child Abuse and Neglect.
